

something was very wrong. I went upstairs and was ushered into Dianne York-Goldman's previous office. I was introduced to Dan Close for the very first time and he immediately told me that he had to let me go. I had no explanation as to why except "due to the financial condition of the company." I was stunned because I had an extensive client of regulars and was bringing in more money and had more return requests than two other estheticians. I still don't have an answer as to what the real reason was. I had to be escorted out by Stasea Milton and was treated as if I'd done something wrong. I tried not to cry so I waited until I met my friend who was my first appointment. She had gone out of her way to come see me and wasn't even notified that I wouldn't be working on her so of course she canceled.
