

## **Declaration of Margo Schwab**

**I, Margaret E. Schwab, also known as Margo Schwab, declare the following to be true and correct, and if asked to testify would be willing to do so in a court of law, in the State of California.**

**In late November, early December I received a message from Dianne York-Goldman. She said she needed to speak to me. I told her I was coming in for an appointment with Dr. Goldman. She said to come by her office after the appointment.**

**After the appointment I spoke with Dianne in her office. I could not have been more surprised. Dianne related then, and in the next few weeks that there had been big problems with Mitch over Thanksgiving at Rancho La Puerta. She said it wasn't the first of problems.**

**She related that he had banged for 45 minutes on their accidentally locked bedroom door very recently and he had been shouting at her. She was scared and wouldn't open the door. The next day the lock was gone from the bedroom door.**

**Over the course of the next few weeks Dianne related other problems. One was a physically abusive incident that had left her black and blue.**

**Other were financial. Dianne said she was noticing that certain irreplaceable documents that were hers were missing.**

**She was worried that they would disappear, so I offered to store them at our house.**

**She said her marriage was basically over.**

**In January, it was clear that it was. On January 6<sup>th</sup>, 2008, Scott and I went to the Goldman's home for dinner. While pouring champagne for us, Mitch announced that they were getting a divorce and he was moving out. Mitch said that he didn't make enough money. He said that Dianne needed to be married to some rich guy like Harry Cooper. He said he couldn't afford the lifestyle she wanted. I later heard from a mutual friend who also is a client of Mitch's, by the name of Valerie Cooper, that Dianne just spent so much on clothing. Valerie made it**

**apparent that at her appointment with Mitch they were discussing the money issues vis a vis Dianne, and she also said that from Mitch she knew that Scott and I had been at 'the last supper together' at the house.**

**He asked for divorce advice. Mine was keep everything private and as amicable as possible, keep the business side professional, and try to divorce without spending an extra dime to attorneys.**

**Mitch moved out a few days later.**

**On February 18<sup>th</sup> at approximately 10:30 am, Scott and I received phone calls separately from Dianne York-Goldman, and from Cynthia on behalf of Dr. Goldman. I asked Cynthia if it was a 911 and she said no. She asked to speak to Scott and I asked her for a number to have him call back on. He gave me Dr. Goldman's cell phone number.**

**I spoke with Dianne who was upset and shaky. She related that police were coming because Dr. Goldman had stormed into her office and had wrestled handily with her over a plaque. She had called 911. She was terrified and in fear because he had done this in front of other people. She said her hand and wrist were cut and bruised. She did not know if it was broken. Dianne also voiced concern that there were a room full of patients and she wanted to do what was best for the business. She did not want Mitch arrested because she thought it would hurt business.**

**Scott called Mitch on his cell phone. I heard Scott tell Mitch not to drop his name, it would not help, and just to tell the truth factually. He said the officers would take statements and make a determination about whether or not to arrest him.**

**As a patient of Dr. Mitchel P. Goldman, I have observed the following.**

**Sometime early in 2008, I went for a booked appointment for Affirm laser. After waiting 45 minutes for my appointment, Dr. Goldman arrived to the appointment. He was late due to a surgery emergency he said. He then found the laser machine to not be in working order. The office had known about the problem apparently days before but no one had followed through and organized to have the machine fixed.**

**Revolving around the same time period, Dr. Goldman made it clear that he did not want to overdue my lips and have me look like 'someone else we know.' It was clear he was referencing his wife Dianne York-Goldman. I thought the comment unnecessary.**

**He also made a comment at one appointment that really rich people didn't need to have their breasts enlarged. Ironically, it is obvious that I have had mine done. The comment did not come off well.**

**On two particular occasions in the Spring of 2008 I rang the medical offices to schedule appointments. On both times the phone went through to voice mail. I left messages to ring me so I could schedule an appointment. Hours later I still had not received a phone call so I called again each time and then got a human live voice and scheduled the appointment.**

**On May 12<sup>th</sup>, I went with my husband Scott Johnston for his Botox appointment with Dr. Goldman. This was his second treatment for Botox, the first being approximately in January. The nurse/ assistant Isabell (sp?) said Scott had never signed a Hipaa/ privacy document which should have been signed at the first visit. Scott then signed it.**

**On three different occasions Dr. Goldman has injected my lips and nasal labial areas. On the first occasion, my lips were uneven and had to be fixed. On the third occasion they are significantly uneven and in fact unfinished in one area. I requested twice to have them fixed and Dr. Goldman first said to wait for swelling to go down, but yes there was one little area, then he said yes the lips was missing a part done but it was a small area and not worth a vial and he thought it best not to re-do the nasal labial area to finish the job because it would break capillaries.**

**Regarding the unfinished work I had my husband Scott ring Dr. Goldman on his cell phone. Scott was not happy to have spent a lot of money on an unfinished and poorly done job. I am not happy that he might charge us again, I will have to go through the pain of injections on another day, the time for bruising and swelling, and I am concerned about the outcome.**
